Clarity for businesses on Queensland's Public Health Directions

Queensland to open up this Monday

Queensland's border will open to all domestic visitors from 1:00am this Monday, 13 December as Queensland is set to achieve 80 per cent vaccination status this week.

- **Fully vaccinated travellers from interstate hotspots** can arrive by road or air, they must provide a negative COVID test in the previous 72 hours and must complete a COVID test on day five after arrival. No quarantine is required.
- There are no restrictions for **travellers arriving from other parts of Australia** (ie. from non-hotspot areas).
- **International arrivals** must be fully vaccinated and return a negative COVID test within 72 hours of departure, they will be required to get a test on arrival and must go into home or hotel quarantine for 14 days.
- **All arrivals**, no matter where from, must complete relevant entry declarations and abide by the public health directions in place at the time.

Information and business resources for vaccine mandate

The mandate on vaccinated staff and patrons in non-essential venues remains unchanged and comes into effect from 5:00am, 17 December 2021.

Today the [Public Health and Social Measures Linked to Vaccination Status Direction](#) was published, providing clarity to businesses ahead of the changes coming into effect next Friday.

The Public Health Direction provides important information for business owners and operators, staff and visitors regarding their obligations.

With Queensland Police enforcing the Public Health Direction, businesses and venues have a responsibility to comply with the Direction with the support of the Queensland Government.
