# Sydney lockdown requirements apply in Queensland



## Do you have guests who have recently been in NSW?

Queensland Health has back-dated its COVID-19 hotspot declaration for some parts of New South Wales, meaning anyone who has arrived in Queensland from the Local Government Areas of Waverley, Woollahra, Randwick or the City of Sydney since 1:00 am on Friday, 11 June 2021 must follow the stay at home requirements as though they were in Sydney.

These visitors can follow the stay at home requirements in their accommodation or home, and must follow them until 14 days have passed since they arrived in Queensland, or until

the requirement is lifted.

Other visitors from other parts of New South Wales do not have to follow this requirement, but they should monitor their health and be tested immediately if they experience any COVID-19 symptoms.

The Interstate Exposure Venue Direction also remains in place - meaning anyone who has been in any interstate exposure sites must quarantine for 14 days.
