Lockdown to end for some parts of Queensland

While lockdown restrictions will continue for the Brisbane and Moreton Bay Local Government Areas (LGAs), other LGAs will finish lockdown at 6:00pm tonight, Friday 2 July.

Restrictions for Brisbane City and Moreton Bay LGAs - and people who have been in those areas since 6:00pm, 29 June 2021:

Lockdown restrictions remain in place until 6:00pm Saturday 3 July 2021, with these people only allowed to leave home for essential reasons. Information will be updated and
